7. Award of the Postgraduate Diploma in Archaeology

7.1 Pass

A candidate is eligible for the Postgraduate Diploma in Archaeology if he/she obtains,

I. Grades of B- or better in each of the course units offered and satisfactorily completes the mandatory field experience period, and

II. Completes the relevant requirements within a period of two academic years.

7.2 Merit Pass

A candidate shall be awarded a Merit Pass provided he/she

- I. Obtains grades of 'A-' or better in each of the course units offered and achieves a minimum GPA of 3.70, and
- II. Completes the relevant requirements in the first attempt

7.3 Distinction Pass

A candidate shall be awarded a Distinction Pass provided he/she

- I. Obtains grades of 'A' or better in each of the course units offered and achieves a minimum GPA of 4.0, and
- II. Completes the relevant requirements in the first attempt.

8. Payments

Total Course Fee Rs.100,000, International Candidate USD 750(USD 500+USD 250)
